IMPETIGO

Your child has a skin infection called **IMPETIGO** which is caused by bacteria (usually Staph or Strep). We treat this bacterial infection with a skin ointment or an oral antibiotic. To help prevent the infection from spreading to other parts of your child's skin, wash the affected areas gently but thoroughly every day with a liquid antibacterial soap.
